

The Renfield Centre 260 Bath St Glasgow (G2 4JP) is well served by public transport.



Trains

Charing Cross Railway Station is 300yards and a 2-minute walk from the Centre.

Anderston Railway Station is ½ mile and 10minute walk from the Centre.

Glasgow Queen St Railway Station is 0.8 miles from the Centre and 15-minute walk. Alternatively, you can take a train from the Lower Level of the station to **Charing Cross Railway Station**-1 stop.

Glasgow Central Railway Station is 0.7miles and a 14minute walk from the Centre. Alternatively, you can catch a 4, or 4A bus outside the station to the Centre.



Buses

Buchanan St Bus Station is 0.6 miles and a 12minute walk. you can catch a No. 77 Bus from here that passes in front of the Centre.

Buses (First Bus) Westbound the following First Bus Services stop in Bath St about 50 yards from the Renfield Centre, Nos 3, 4, 4 A, 77. The number 18 terminates in Holland St adjacent to the Centre. The No 2 stops in St Vincent St which is a 5minute walk to the Centre.

Buses (First Bus) Eastbound the following First Bus Services stop in Sauchiehall St about 50 yards from the Renfield Centre, Nos 3, 4, 4 A, 77. The number 19 terminates in Holland St adjacent to the Centre. The No 2 stops in St Vincent St which is a 5minute walk to the Centre.

Taxi



There is a Black Hackney Cab rank in Holland St, adjacent to the Renfield Centre.

Glasgow Airport



Glasgow Airport is serviced by the No 77 bus service operated by First Bus.

Prestwick Airport



Prestwick Airport is about 40 miles from Glasgow but has a train link to Glasgow Central Railway Station.

By Car



From the East and North exit the M8. Take the Charing Cross Exit and veer left into Sauchiehall St, continue along until Pitt St, turn right into Pitt St, and the next junction turn right into Bath St the Renfield Centre is 200 yards on your right.

From the West exit the Clydeside Expressway for Charing Cross continue straight on passing St Patricks RC Church on your left. At the junction with St Vincent St turn right, at the second set of traffic lights turn left into Elmbank St and opt for on street parking or a Car Park.

From the South exit the Kingston Bridge for City Centre (Bothwell St off ramp). At the first set of traffic lights turn left into Pitt St continue along Pitt St and at the second junction turn left into West George St. then take the first right into to Holland St and opt for on street parking or a Car Park.

Parking

On street parking there are metered bay in streets surrounding the Renfield Centre and operate from 8:00am until 6:00pm, 7 days a week.

On street parking is metered on Mondays to Fridays in streets around the Mitchell Library, a 5minute walk from the Renfield Centre, 8:00am until 6:00pm Granville St, Kent Road, Berkeley St, Newton Terrace, Somerset Place etc but is ***currently*** free on Saturdays and Sundays.

Drivers of vehicles are responsible for checking for any parking restrictions in force including temporary restrictions. Neither the Renfield Centre nor the event organiser are responsible for any parking penalties incurred.

Car Parks

There are Car Parks at

- Elmbank Cres
- Q Park at Sauchiehall St Centre enter from Bath St at West Campbell St.
- Sikh Temple Berkeley St. (Monday to Friday)
